Bills in Congress:

- The **U.S. National Health Insurance Act/Expanded and Improved Medicare for All Act (Conyers Bill, H.R. 676)** establishes the U.S. National Health Insurance Program to provide all individuals residing in the U.S. and U.S. territories with free health-care that includes all medically necessary care, such as primary care and prevention, prescription drugs, emergency care, and mental health services. - The **Medicare for All Act (Kennedy Bill, S.2229)** ensures that all Americans have access to high-quality, affordable health care that is as good as what their member of Congress receives, and reduces the cost of health care while enhancing American competitiveness in the global marketplace. <http://www.govtrack.us/congress/bill.xpd?bill=s109-2229>
